**BECOME A VOLUNTEER VICTIM ADVOCATE AND HELP  
VICTIMS OF CRIME BEGIN TO HEAL**

Tucson, Arizona – The Victim Services Division of the Pima County Attorney's Office is recruiting community volunteers to serve as advocates for crime victims. Victim Advocates support victims after a crime or other trauma has occurred, responding both to individual crime scenes as well as large-scale incidents like the January 8, 2011 Tucson Tragedy.

Victim Advocates help survivors of trauma and victimization on their road to recovery and healing by providing them with crisis intervention services, emotional support, and resources and referrals. The Victim Services Division is currently seeking additional volunteers who can help do this type of important work within the community.

Anyone interested in learning more about the Victim Services Division, what it is doing to help the citizens of Pima County, and volunteer opportunities, must attend one of two information sessions:

- Monday, February 3, 2014 from 6:00-8:00 pm
- Monday, February 10, 2014 from 6:00-8:00 pm

Both sessions will be held at the Tucson Police Department Substation, 1310 W. Miracle Mile.

The Victim Services Division provides volunteers and interested community members with extensive training. The Crisis Intervention and Victimology Training, which is open to anyone in the community, will be held on Monday and Wednesday evenings for six weeks beginning February 24, 2014. Those interested in attending the training or volunteering must first attend one of the information sessions. After attending an information session, there will be an application and interview process for prospective volunteers.
