PIMA COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE PROVIDES INSIDE LOOK INTO THE PAST 100 YEARS OF COUNTY ATTORNEYS

TUCSON, ARIZONA – In honor of Arizona's centennial year as a state, the Pima County Attorney's Office is launching a new webpage to provide a greater appreciation for the history of law enforcement in our community.

The new webpage allows users to click through a timeline of the past 100 years in the Pima County Attorney's Office. The easy-to-navigate historical journey provides biographical information about previous county attorneys and highlights of their careers.

Among the fascinating facts:

- Rose Silver was the first female graduate of the University of Arizona Law School.
- David Dingledine served twice as Pima County Attorney but was never elected.
- Morris "Mo" Udall played professional basketball for the Denver Nuggets.

Research for the webpage was performed in-house and included obtaining facts from families, friends, and past county attorneys. The page will continue to grow and be updated as more information becomes available. The public is encouraged to participate in this continued research by visiting the page and sending any additional information or photos they may have.

"This is the first attempt to capture the amazing history of the Pima County Attorney's Office," said Barbara LaWall, who has held the post longer than all but one of her 23 predecessors. "It brings the past to life in an informative way."
